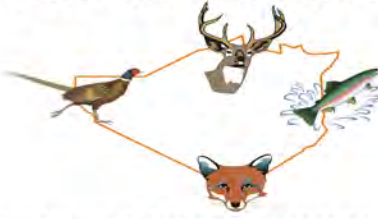

Agreement made this _____ day of _____, 2017 between the Orange County Federation of Sportsmen's Clubs, Inc., hereinafter referred to as O.C.F.S.C., and Black Rock Fish Game Club of Cornwall N Y Inc. and/or Shawangunk Fish and Game Club Inc of Middletown, N Y _____, hereinafter referred to as Vendor, with respect to said organization's Flea Market to be held on Saturday, July 15, 2017, from 8:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. on the grounds of the Black Rock Fish and Game Club off Route 32 in Mountainville, N.Y., and/or on Saturday August 19, 2017, from 8 A M to 3 P M at Shawangunk Fish & Game Association, 37 Denman Road, Middletown NY. **Both Event Dates are Rain or Shine NO REFUNDS**

Vendor agrees to rent ____ 15'x30' Field Space(s) at \$25 each. at Black Rock (*SPACES NEXT TO PAVILION ARE **STILL \$35.**)

Vendor agrees to rent ____ 15'x30' Field Space(s) at \$25 each. at Shawangunk (or SPECIAL RATE OF \$20.00 per space when renting space at both events.)

Vendor agrees to rent ____ 6'x 10' covered Pavilion Space(s) at \$40 each at Black Rock.

Vendor agrees to rent ____ 6'x 10' covered Pavilion Space(s) at \$40 each as Shawangunk (or SPECIAL RATE OF \$30.00 per space when renting space at both events.)

1. Assignment to specific spaces is at the sole discretion of O.C.F.S.C., and spaces may not be shared, sublet or otherwise transferred without express written permission from O.C.F.S.C.
2. No tables, display materials or electrical connections provided. (except 1 Adirondack style picnic table w/each pavilion Space.)
3. Vendor is responsible for the clean and orderly operation of the rented space(s,) and for the cleanup, and removal of any refuse generated therein.
4. Vendor may not display or distribute material of any kind outside the assigned space(s,) and may not possess, display or distribute any material in violation of federal, state or local law or regulation.
5. Vendor is solely and completely responsible for compliance with all applicable safety, licensing, tax, or other laws and regulations, including instructions given by O.C.F.S.C. regarding parking, setup, display and conduct on the grounds of Black Rock Fish and Game Club and/or Shawangunk Fish and Game Association.
6. O.C.F.S.C. reserves the right to remove any item or to change the manner in which it is displayed.
7. No food or beverages of any kind may be sold or distributed without the express written permission of O.C.F.S.C.
8. Pets and animals are not permitted on the grounds with the exception of service animals for the disabled, or as otherwise expressly permitted in writing by O.C.F.S.C.
9. Vendor will provide for the prompt setup of the rented space(s) in time for the opening at 8:00 A.M. and will not dismantle their display before 3:00 P.M. except as directed by O.C.F.S.C.
10. In the event of inclement weather, O.C.F.S.C. in its sole discretion will determine whether the Flea Market will remain open. If it closes, all vendors must leave as directed and no refund or credit will be issued, except as determined by O.C.F.S.C. in its sole discretion. Otherwise, vendor's property must be removed from the grounds by 4:30 P.M.
11. Vendor agrees to hold harmless and indemnify O.C.F.S.C. and the Black Rock Fish and Game Club and Shawangunk Fish & Game Association, their officers, directors, members, employees, volunteers, agents, and representatives, from all liability, loss, claims, suits and/or judgments of any type arising from this agreement. Vendor further agrees that under no circumstances shall any entity mentioned above have any liability whatsoever for incidental or consequential loss or damages, or injury or death of any person, resulting from vendor's use of the grounds under this agreement.
12. Vendor agrees that its sole and exclusive remedy under this agreement for any reason shall be limited to the rental fee collected by O.C.F.S.C. Vendor specifically waives any and all other rights or remedies which might be available in equity or in law, including the right to seek damages whether special, incidental, consequential or otherwise.
13. If any party hereto brings any suit or other action against another for relief, declaratory or otherwise, arising from this agreement, losing party shall pay the prevailing party's costs and expenses, including attorneys' fees and court costs.
14. The signatory for the vendor affirms that s/he has full authority to agree to the foregoing on behalf of the vendor and any and all individuals who enter the grounds on behalf of the vendor.
